Guillaume Tonnelier was born December 10, 1655 in Plelan LeGrand, Ille-et-Vilaine, France and died 1740 in Scarborough, Yorkshire, England.

He married Mrs. Guillaum Tonnelier 1700 in France. She was born abt. 1679 in France, and died unknown in Scarborough, Yorkshire, England.

Guillaume left France about 1703 to escape religious persecution.

Third Generation

**William Tunnell** b. abt. 1702, Normandy, France; d. December 28, 1787, Loudon Co., Virginia.  
Between 1702 - 1703, known to be living near Scarborough, North Riding, Yorkshire, England.

**John** b. Abt. 1704, Scarborough, Yorkshire, England; d. Unknown.

**James** b. Abt. 1706, Scarborough, Yorkshire, England; d. Unknown.

William Tunnell (as he was known after arriving in the colonies).

He married "Lady" Ann "Howard" between 1731 and 1735 in Yorkshire, England.

"Lady Ann" thought to have been born abt. 1710. William and Ann emigrated to the English Colonies in America at some time during that interval and settled near Fredericksburg, Virginia. Later they moved to Fairfax County and lived near the falls of the Potomac. William

Tunnell died December 28, 1787, it is thought in Loudon County, Virginia and was buried in Fairfax County.

"Lady Ann" died February 18, 1814 in Robertsville, Anderson Co., Tennessee. Even then she was referred to as "Lady Ann".
